The Attendance Committee wants to relay some very important information regarding absences, school tardiness, signing out of school early, and attendance policy.

DATA HIGHLIGHTS

East Lee County High School Attendance Goal for 2022-2023 is **92%**. East Lee County High School year-to-date attendance rate as of March 31, 2023 is **88.6%**. We are almost there! Let's finish strong! Let's go East!

Attendance Policy Reminders from our attendance policy:

- 5 parent notes for absences per semester
- 5 parent notes for tardies per semester
- Proper documentation (doctor/dentist notes, etc., A parent note will only excuse 5 absences per semester.
- Family travel plans or vacations should be planned outside of school being in session or they will count as an unexcused absence.

Sign- Out Process

East Lee County High School is a closed campus. Students are expected to remain on campus from the time they arrive until school is officially dismissed. Appointments should be scheduled after school hours, but in the event that it isn't possible, a doctor's note should be turned in the day the student returns to school. If your student is a driver, walker, and/or ride a bike to school, and must leave school early, in order to facilitate a quick and efficient sign-out process, please complete the East Lee County High School Electronic Sign-Out Google Form located on our website. Electronic sign out requests should be submitted prior 10:00am daily. The form requires the student's name, student ID number, date, reason for sign out, telephone number where a parent/guardian may be reached that morning to verify sign-out. Sign-outs after 1:00p.m. are prohibited per School Board Policy 4.16(e) (1). Students 18 years of age or older must follow the same sign out procedures.

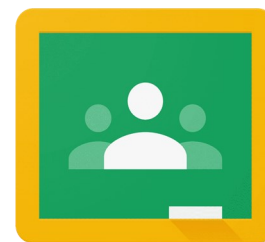

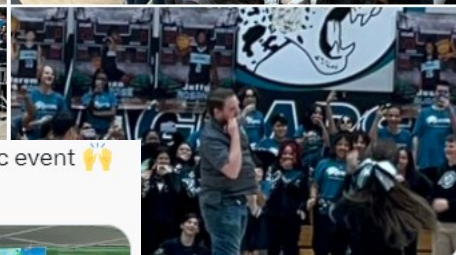

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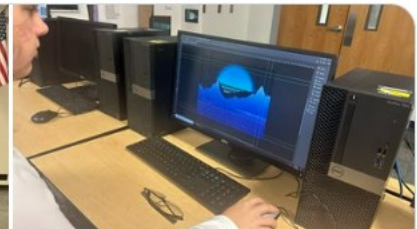
