



#### **Sign-Out Process**

If your student is a driver, walker, and/or rides a bike to school, and must leave school early, in order to facilitate a quick and efficient sign-out process, please complete the East Lee County High School Electronic Sign-Out Google Form located on our website. Electronic sign out requests should be submitted prior 10:00 am daily. The form requires the student's name, student ID number, date, reason for sign out, and telephone number where a parent/guardian may be reached that morning to verify sign-out. Sign-outs after 1:00 pm are prohibited per School Board Policy 4.16(e) (1). Students 18 years of age or older must follow the same sign out procedures.






